

2026 International Student Recruitment Plan for Six-year English-taught MBBS Program

I. Major

Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS) is a full-time six-year English-taught program for international students. The main courses include: human anatomy, histoembryology, physiology, cytology and biochemistry, medical genetics, immunology, pathogenic biology, pathology, pathophysiology, pharmacology, diagnostics, internal medicine, surgery, obstetrics and gynecology, pediatrics, traditional Chinese medicine, psychiatry, etc. Please refer to Appendix for a general idea of the course arrangement, and the specific arrangement should be based on the curriculum of the year of enrollment.

II. Qualifications

Applicants should be between 18-35 years old (No later than Dec. 31st of that year, Dec. 31st included.), high school graduate or above, non-Chinese citizen with non-criminal record, in good health and with a good command of English (IELTS 6.5 / TOEFL IBT 85 or above).

☆ Applicants who are native English-speakers or have studied in English-taught high schools are not required to submit English proficiency certificates.

☆ Applicants who are immigrants from the Chinese mainland, Hong Kong, Macao, and Taiwan (China) and are a foreign national, or whose parents are both Chinese citizens and have settled abroad, or who have been a foreign national since birth must meet the requirements of the Ministry of Education's Jiao Wai Han [2020] No.12;

☆ If the applicant is under the age of 18 before 31st August of the application year, the guardian is required to provide supplementary materials. See "IV. Application Materials" for details.

IV. Application Materials

Note: Only the electronic version of the application materials should be uploaded in the application system during the application. If you are accepted, please make sure to bring the original paper version of the application materials for verification when you come to school. If you are unable to submit, or if the materials do not match, you will be disqualified

from admission.

1. Personal information page of your passport (Passport valid until March1, 2027and beyond).

2. High school graduation certificate

-New graduates must submit the original anticipated graduation certificate issued by their school. Versions in languages other than Chinese or English must be accompanied by a notarized translation.

-For a Malaysian SPM diploma, the certificate of completion of STPM or one-year preparatory studies and a transcript of the preparatory courses are also required.

3. Original or notarized transcripts of all high school courses

-For a transcript in a language other than Chinese and English, the original notarized copy must be provided.

-We recommend that you attach a description of the evaluation criteria of the transcripts.

-The results of the national senior high school entrance examination or the internationally accepted test results of the country of origin, such as UEC/A Level/AP/IB/SAT/ACT, can also be submitted as supplementary materials.

4. The result of the 'China Scholastic Competency Assessment ' (CSCA Test) issued by the Minist1.All undergraduate program applicants (including those applying for various scholarships, self-funded students, and programs taught in Chinese or English) must take the "China Scholastic Competency Assessment " (CSCA) for Undergraduate Admission, organized by the China Scholarship Council under the Ministry of Education, before submitting their application to our university. Applicants must upload their CSCA score report when submitting their application. For specific exam registration information, please visit the CSCA official website: www.csc.cn.

For students applying for MBBS, the subjects of the CSC A exam you need to take are Mathematics and Chemistry (the test papers are in English).

5. Copy of English proficiency certificate: IELTS 6.5 / TOEFL IBT 85 or above. The original certificate is required to be submitted at the registration, if the student is admitted. (☆Applicants who are native English-speakers or have studied in English-medium high schools are not required to submit English proficiency certificates.

6. Physical Health Report (in the last six months).

7. Personal Statement

Please write your introduction according to the personal statement template (click the attachment at the bottom of the web page to download)in the teaching language of the professional program (for example, the statement for a program taught in Chinese should be

written in Chinese, and the statement for a program taught in English should be written in English).

8. Admission priority will be given to applicants holding New HSK Level 4 Certificates. Admission priority will be given to applicants who can provide letters of recommendation/personal statement. Admission priority will be given to applicants who can provide other supporting materials, e.g. award certificates, foreign entrance examination transcripts, university admission notice, etc.

9. Proof of payment of the registration fee;

For remittance through offline bank or online bank, it is necessary to submit a photo of the remittance voucher or a screenshot of the online remittance.

It is not necessary to submit the remittance through the online application system. Payment can be made in the system upon submission of the application.

Applicants who have not paid the registration fee will not be reviewed.

10. If the applicant is under the age of 18 before 31st August of the application year, the guardian is required to provide the following materials:

- Guardian is a Chinese citizen: upload a scanned copy of the resident ID card; bank deposit certificate (amount not less than RMB 100,000, with a validity date later than January 31, 2027).

- Guardian is a foreign national: Upload a scanned copy of the passport (information page); non-student residence permit (valid after January 31, 2027); bank deposit certificate (amount not less than RMB 100,000, with a validity date beyond January 31, 2027).

- Guardian Guarantee Letter (click the attachment at the bottom of the web page to download)

11. Applicants who are immigrants from the Chinese mainland, Hong Kong, Macao, and Taiwan (China) and are a foreign national, applicants whose parents are one or both Chinese citizens and have settled abroad, and applicants who have been a foreign national since birth must provide the following materials:

- Former Chinese citizens who have subsequently become foreign nationals must submit:

- (1) Proof of acquiring foreign nationality (the date of acquiring foreign nationality is earlier than April 30, 2022);

- (2) Scanned copy of entry and exit signature records on the passport from April 30, 2022 to the time of application submission (for those who have lived in a foreign country for more than 2 years, residence for 9 months in a year in that country can be counted as one year);

- (3) Letter of Commitment

- Applicants who became a foreign national at birth in a foreign country with one or both parents being a Chinese citizen must submit:

- Certificate of the applicant's acquisition of foreign nationality at birth (① if one or both of the parents are Chinese citizens with permanent residence abroad, certificate of the corresponding permanent residence needs to be provided; ② if one or both of the parents are Chinese citizens without permanent residence abroad, certificate of the withdrawal from Chinese nationality of the applicant needs to be provided.);

(1) Scanned copy of entry and exit signature records on the passport from April 30, 2022 to the time of application submission (for those who have lived in a foreign country for more than 2 years, residence for 9 months in a year can be counted as one year);

(2) Letter of Commitment

Please upload the above materials to the “Supplementary Materials” column of the application system.

According to applicable regulations, Chinese foreigners, including former Chinese citizens who are foreign nationals, their children of foreign nationality, and Chinese citizens’ children of foreign nationality, must pass the pre-examination of nationality conducted by the school at the admission stage, and the nationality assessment conducted by the exit and entry administration department of the Chinese public security organ after enrollment.

Applicants who do not pass the nationality pre-examination or the nationality assessment will be considered to have voluntarily withdrawn their application. As a result, any admission approval or student status subsequently granted will be automatically revoked.

☆ In addition to the application materials mentioned above, the university may require applicants to provide supplementary materials, depending on the updated policies. The application documents will not be returned.

V. Application and Admission Procedure

1. All undergraduate program applicants (including those applying for various scholarships, self-funded students, and programs taught in Chinese or English) must take the "China Scholastic Competency Assessment " (CSCA) for Undergraduate Admission, organized by the China Scholarship Council under the Ministry of Education, before submitting their application to our university. Applicants must upload their CSCA score report when submitting their application. For specific exam registration information, please visit the CSCA official website: www.csc.cn. For students applying for MBBS, the subjects of the CSC A exam you need to take are Mathematics and Chemistry (the test papers are in English).

2. Complete the Tongji Online Application procedure at the website <http://study-info.tongji.edu.cn>. You MUST submit all application materials online.

Please refer to "IV. Application Materials" for detailed list of materials. When filling out the form, please note that the English name should be consistent with the passport. If there is no Chinese name, the system will generate it automatically.

3. Pay the application fee by bank transfer and submit the photocopy of transfer voucher with other documents or pay it directly through the Tongji Online Application system.

The online application fee is RMB600, which is non-refundable.

4. After the online review of documents is approved, the applicant will be informed to participate in the admission interview.

5. Attend the admission interview (offline or online) organized by the school of medicine, and the interview results will be sent by email within two weeks after the interview.

6. Waiting for the Preliminary Admission results and Pay the Tuition Fee

Applicants who have passed the academic review and granted "Waiting for Preliminary Admission" status must pay the first academic year's tuition within two weeks from the date of the preliminary admission result announcement to confirm their enrollment. Specific payment instructions will be notified via email after the preliminary admission results are released.

7. Download the admission documents

After the applicant changes their system status to 'Completed,' our school will notify admitted students through the system to download the electronic official admission documents. For information related to reporting to the school, please follow the updates in the 'Orientation' section on the website.

Note:

- Applicants are advised to regularly check the messages and application status in the application system after submission. It is essential to follow the instructions provided by the university to complete each step. Any delays caused by not checking notifications in time will be the sole responsibility of the applicant.

- The university will not provide explanations for applications that do not pass the review.

VI. Expenses:

1. Tuition: RMB 45000 / year,

2. Compulsory insurance: about RMB 800 yuan / year

☆ The above two items should be paid at the registration

3. Application fee: RMB 600 / time

☆ Application fee should be paid when applying and the fee is non-refundable.

VII. Other Information

1. The first year of international undergraduate students' enrollment is a trial period. If the applicant fails to pass the course with 25 credits or fails to meet the requirements issued by the college in first academic year, the applicant will be expelled and not permitted to study for a second year.

2. The registration time is around the beginning of September 2026, and the specific date is subject to the admission notice of Tongji University. Accepted candidates must go to a Chinese embassy (consulate) abroad to apply for a study visa with their passport, Tongji University Admission Notice, and the Visa Application Form for Foreign Students in China (JW202). Candidates must take the above-mentioned materials and go to Tongji University to apply for admission at the time specified in the notice and apply for a residence certificate in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Exit and Entry Administration Bureau of Shanghai Public Security Bureau.

When reporting to the university, please bring the original application materials that meet the admission requirements (including language proficiency certificates, high school transcripts, and high school diploma). If the verification of materials does not meet the admission requirements, the admission qualification will be canceled.

3. Accommodation: Please follow the accommodation selection notice of Tongji University International Student Office. In principle, full scholarship students will be arranged for accommodation by the school, but the availability of dormitories on campus is limited. If the reservation for dormitories on campus is full, students (including full scholarship students) are requested to arrange their own accommodation during their study abroad period.

Before your application, students are suggested to have a check in their local city or country to confirm that after you graduate from Tongji University School of Medicine, you are able to take the doctor/physician licensing exam there. If you want to practice in the third country, you have to confirm it the same.
